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CFANS Undergraduate Conference Grant Application

The College of Food, Agricultural and Natural Resource Sciences will offer up to 25 **\$100 grants** during academic year 2021-22 for undergraduate students to support participation in regional, national, and international conferences for professional and/or academic development related to CFANS majors.

Conference Grant Guidelines:

- Awards are made for attendance/participation in a conference that takes place between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022.
- Awards will be determined on a monthly basis between September 2021 and April 2022, and there are a limited number of awards available each month. The monthly deadline is the **last Monday of each month**, with one exception: the December deadline will be December 13, 2021.
- Funding is for **CFANS undergraduate students only**. All students funded must be currently full-time enrolled during the term of payment and must have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average at the time of the conference.
- Students must be making satisfactory progress toward an academic degree in CFANS, be in good academic standing and have no financial holds.
- Priority will be given to students who are presenting or competing at the conference. Funding is available for individual students but not for student groups.
- Requests for funding must be made **in advance** of the conference.
- The grant **does not cover food or beverage costs**.
- Students are expected to seek financial support from their departments, student government, or other appropriate sources in addition to seeking support from CFANS.
- This application form is to be completed by the student making the request and endorsed by a faculty member or academic advisor.

- The application is to be submitted by the endorser as a means of signing the application.
- The awards are scholarships applied to your student account after the conference expenses are
 - Awards at the end of a semester may need to be applied to a future semester, in which you must remain a CFANS student.
 - Awards in the summer will need to be applied to fall semester unless you are enrolled in summer courses.
 - Students with financial aid for the full cost of attendance may need to have other aid reduced to accommodate the scholarship.
